## General:

a. School Finances. Budget was reviewed with Murray, and the everyday operations will not change as a result of the Alberta Government Budget. No staffing issues, no teaching positions will be cut. The budget that was given by the government, is a 'tabled' budget, and this may not be the working budget for the year, however, schools are still working under the current framework. Budget deadlines for the Division have been pushed back to June 30.
