#### 6. New Business

- a. ASCA loss of funding –for information.
- -Alberta School Council Association lost 75% of budget, down to \$150,000 funding.
- -A question was asked —what support have they offered to our school council in the past? —support was offered for how to run a school council, meeting topics, seminars...maybe no general meeting this year.
  - b. Return to online schooling 7-12 -Discussion.
- -Reliable Internet –suggestions are if having connection issues, turn off all other electronics in the house such as smart TV, cell phones, gaming system. A suggestion to have day time wifi password and evening password to free up the usage for online schooling.
- -If student has trouble with internet teachers are available all day for support. Can call, email.
- -As a last resort paper packages for students are available.
- -Everything is posted to google classroom, students can access anytime.
- -Telus as bump up internet option, I want Wireless is another option.
- -Parents are encouraged to communicate any challenges and teachers will help trouble shoot and come up with solutions. Will work with families.

#### 7. General Discussion

- -Children in both schools —Is it an option to keep Routhier students home as well at this time? No that is not an option at this time. All students will have online learning from January 4-11. Teachers can not teach both online and in class at the same time. AHL is not an option at this time because next change is set for February.
- -If a student in Routhier did stay home, that would be parent choice and teacher can support with information but they would not receive instruction.
- -Moms pantry –early December, no date yet. Will social distance distribute, maybe Knights Hall in Falher (RFES fundraiser).
