Hello GPV readers,
Once again, June rolls around much quicker than expected. As we finish the last units of study and begin the review process in preparation for final exams, it is important to keep our focus on achievement. The last field trips for the year are scheduled, the last school sporting competitions have wrapped up, the year end concerts are upon us and the days are getting longer.



As I reflect back on the year, I'm happy to say that our provincial measures are showing progress and a trend upwards. Most notably there is an **11%** increase in the Welcoming, Caring, Respectful and Safe Learning Environments (WCRSLE) measure and nearly **8%** increase in Citizenship. Couple these with a **91%** 3-year completion rate and we begin to see a picture of a school culture focussed on academic success coupled with a strong sense of community.

Science 20 students will be participating in Land Based Learning on Thursday June 4th 2026.

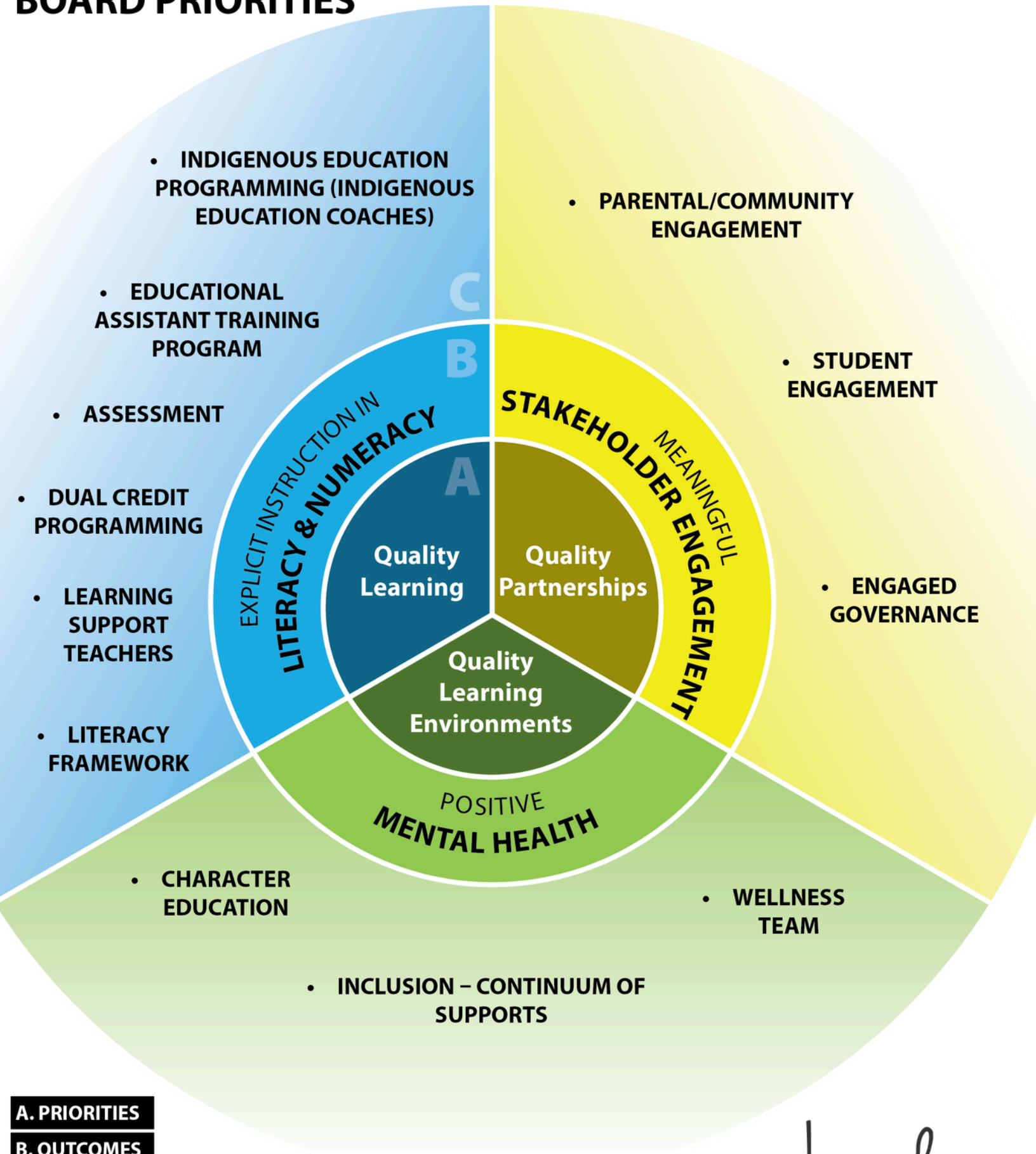
Youth Council for Reconciliation meetings continue.
