b. Healthy schools nutrition admin procedure.

What is the number 1 concern of invested parties; fundraising or the food. Food: Parents and staff responded with the concern that the program is sending confusing and mixed messaging to the students. What is healthy, what is not and not how to find moderation in food choices. And questioning, how food is determined to be healthy versus unhealthy? Suggestion that little to no consultation was done with parents before the full program was implemented. The full extent of the effects on parents, students and staff was not considered. Felt that this was more of a "this is what we are doing" roll out of the program.

Fundraising: Big dent in fundraising options. Very limiting and affects our local businesses as well. We are a small community and now we are limited in or no longer able to use the local restaurants and businesses.

Karin explains that this program came from Central Admin and started 6 years ago, with a slower roll 50/50, 80/20 and then where we are today. Would seem that the parents were not aware of the gradual changes that were taking place in the schools and felt that it was a complete surprise. Karin confirmed that the program will not go as far as to monitor lunches brought to school from home by the students for their personal consumption.

Parents and staff voiced the concerns that there needs to be more discussion and all parties need to find a more reasonable solution.

- Quotes in Bathroom, Melissa was given a firm no. Cleaning, fire code were offered as 2 of the reasons. Maybe the mirrors would be an option? Melissa will ask.
  GPV has not looked into this yet.
